### Taxable Transactions



Notice 2014-21, as modified by Notice 2023-34, states that digital assets should be treated as property for federal tax purposes.








### Reporting Requirements

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#### Check "Yes"

Taxpayers must generally check the "Yes" box if they transacted in digital assets during the year.

### **(**)

#### Check "No"

Taxpayers may check "No" when their DA activity consists **only** of the following:

- Held in a wallet or account.
- Transferred between accounts or addresses controlled by taxpayer.
- Purchased using fiat currency, including through electronic platforms (i.e., PayPal, Venmo).



### Common Questions

Q: Do I have to check 'yes' if I only transfer DAs between wallets but incur a transaction fee?

A: Yes, if the transaction fee is paid in digital assets

Q: Do I have to check 'yes' if I am gifting a digital asset?

A: Yes, because you are disposing a financial interest in a digital asset.

Q: Do I have to check 'yes' if I dispose of my interests in an Exchange Traded Fund (ETP)?

A: No, because the digital asset would still be classified as a security at that time.

Q: Are Venmo/Zelle transactions reportable?

A: No, not unless it is an actual digital asset being transacted.



#### **Transaction Fees**

Amount Realized = \$298.18

(-) Transaction Fee = \$0.30

Adj. Amount Realized = \$297.88



#### Capital Gain/Loss

Adj. Amount Realized = \$297.88

(-) Adjusted Basis = \$250

Capital Gain = \$47.88

#### **Transaction Fees**

Amount Realized = \$221,633.19

(-) Transaction Fee = \$6.64

**Adj. Amount Realized = \$221,626.55** 



#### Capital Gain/Loss

Adj. Amount Realized = \$221,626.55

(-) Adjusted Basis = \$225,000.00

Capital Loss = \$3,373.45
