Take steps now to prepare to file your federal income tax return with these tips

Make your first stop IRS.gov where you'll find online tools to help you get the information you need. The tools are easy-to-use and available 24 hours a day. Millions of people use them to help file and pay taxes, find information about their accounts and get answers to tax questions.

Steps you can take now to make tax filing easier

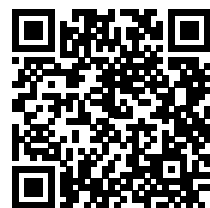
- Create or access your IRS Online Account for services and information
- Gather and organize your tax records. File when you have all your tax documents
- Check your individual tax identification number (ITIN) for renewal
- Get an identity protection personal identification number (IP PIN)
- Open a bank account to speed tax refunds with direct deposit

What's new and what to consider the next time you file

- Know how to report payments for goods and services if you receive Form 1099-K
- Understand how to report digital asset transactions and what to do if you receive Form 1099-DA
- Make sure you've withheld enough tax
- Become familiar with tax law changes that may affect your tax refund
- Avoid refund delays and understand refund timing
