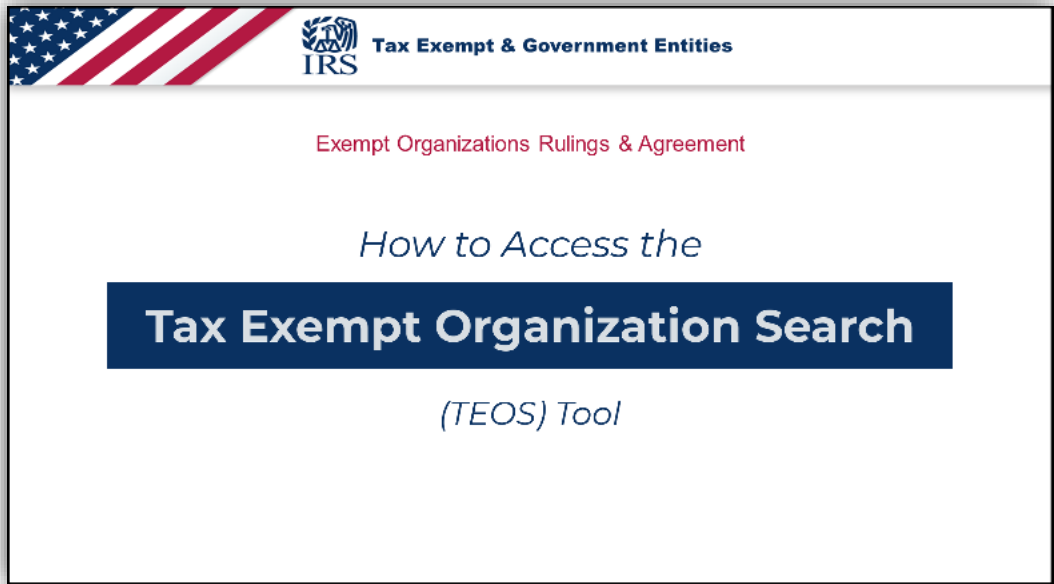


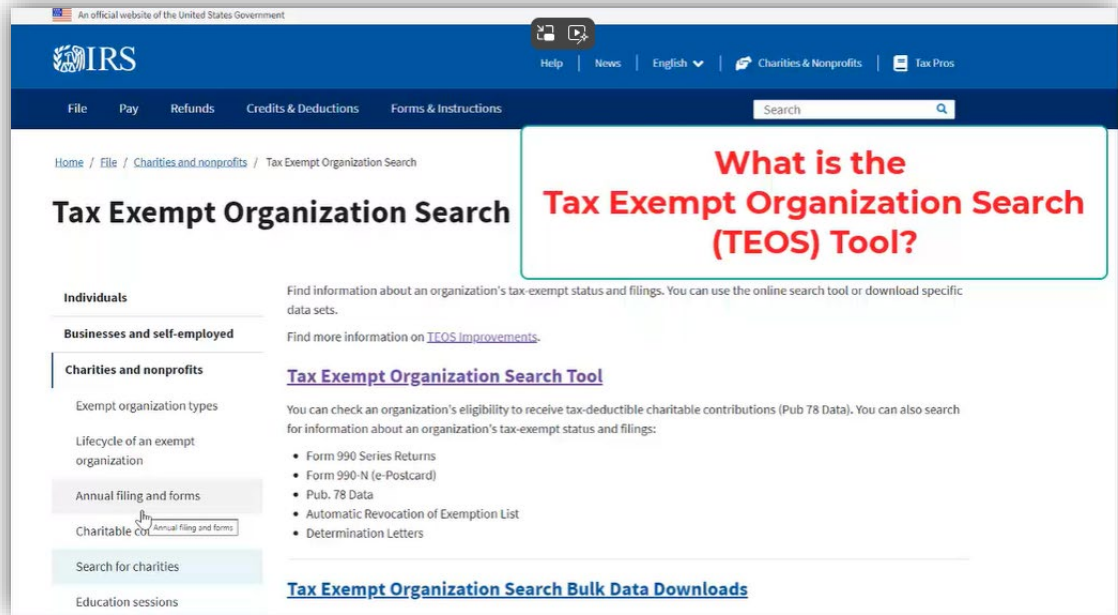

Hello, this video shows how to access the Tax-Exempt Organization Search (TEOS) tool.

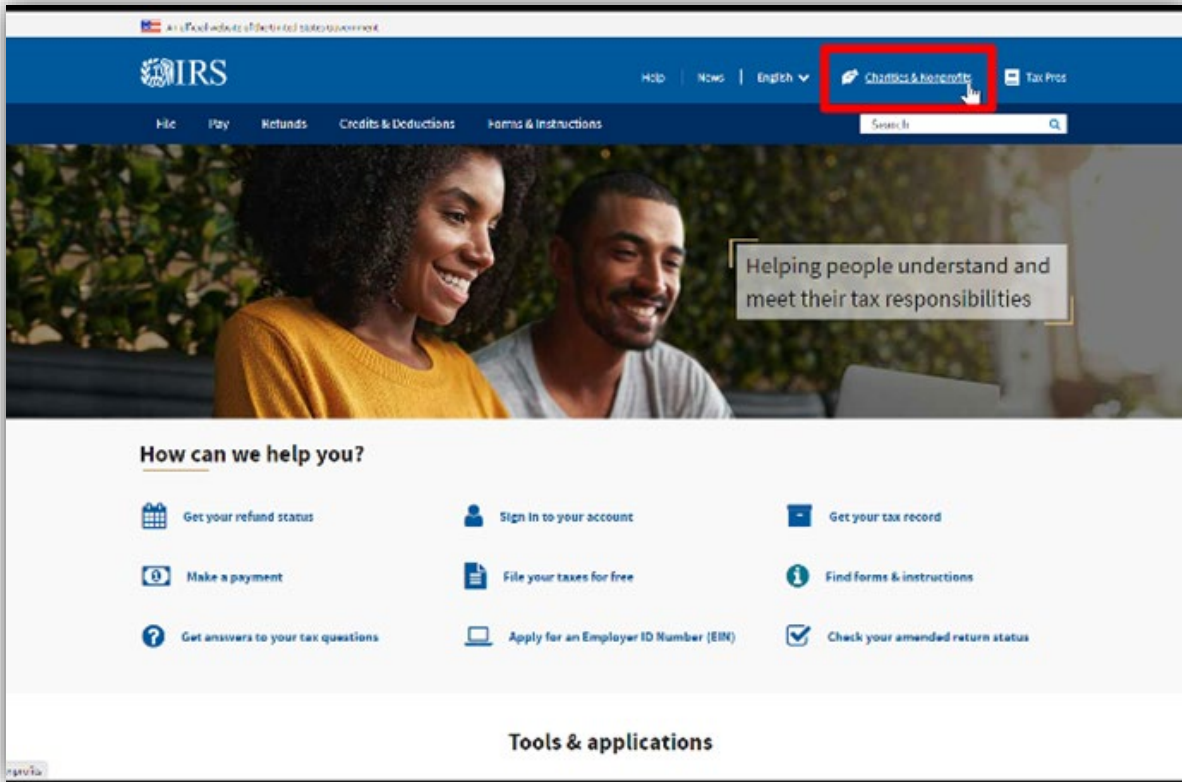


TEOS is a research tool to find information on a tax-exempt organization's status and filings. You can use the online search tool or download specific data sets.

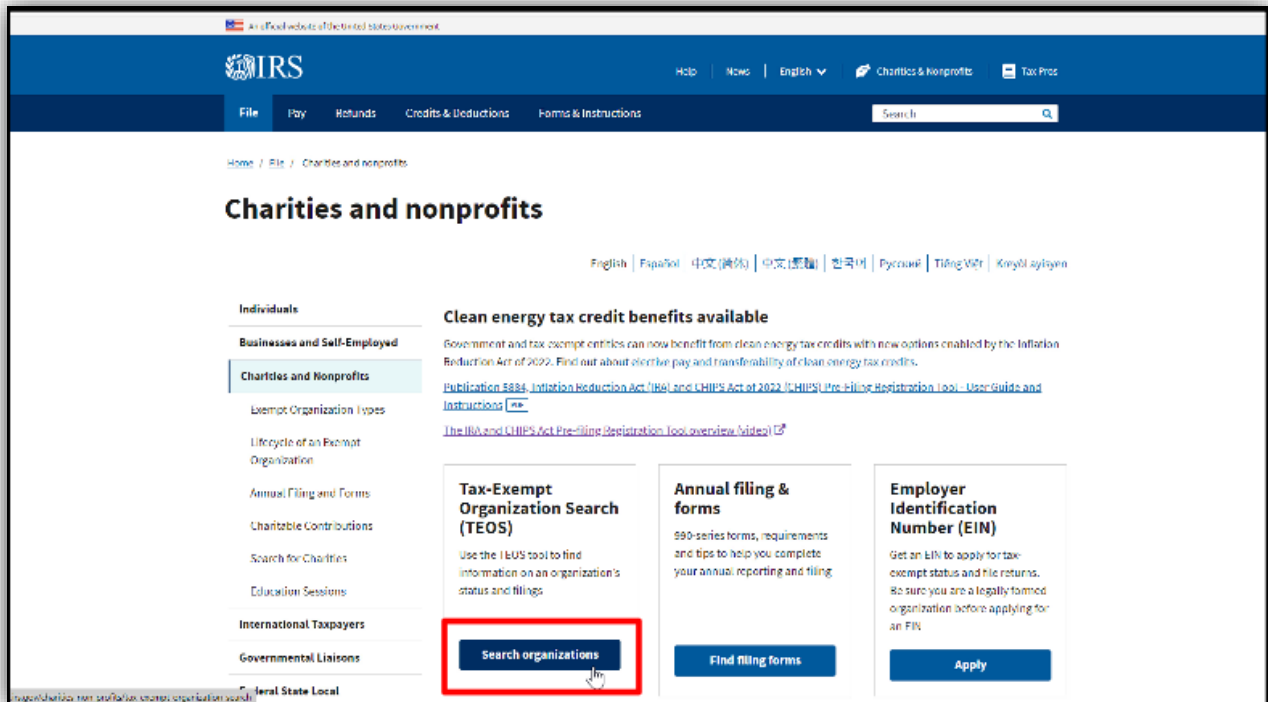


Slide 2: Accessing TEOS

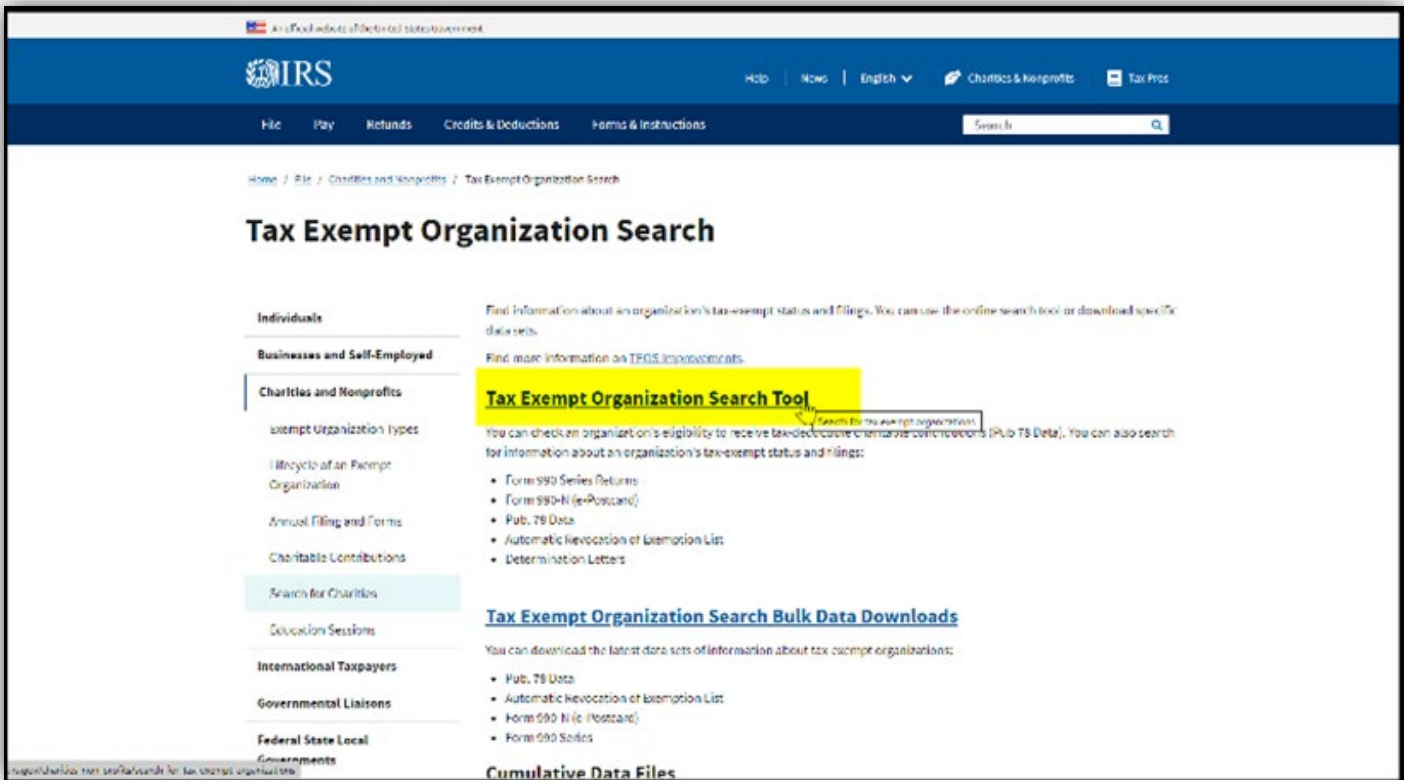
To access TEOS, start on the IRS.gov homepage and click on the Charities & Nonprofits link.



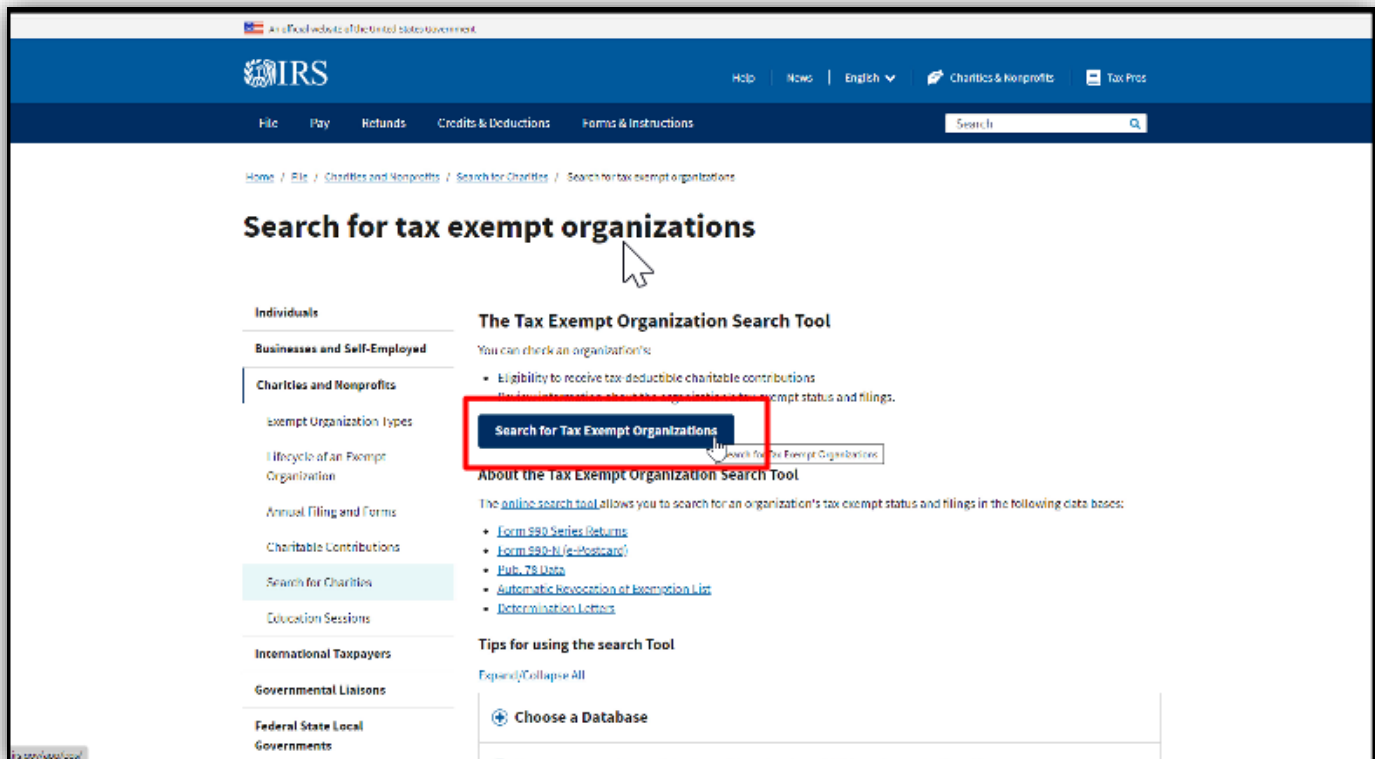
Slide 3: On the Charities and Nonprofits homepage at www.irs.gov/charities, scroll down and click on the Search Organizations blue tab in the TEOS box.



Slide 4: On the Search for Tax Exempt Organizations page, click the Tax Exempt Organization Search Tool.



Slide 5: On the Search for Tax Exempt Organizations page, click the “Search for Tax Exempt Organization” blue tab.
